



Please note that this is the cost per annum and not per course. So if a two year TVET course is undertaken, the listed fee has to be paid in both the first year and then again in the second year of the course.

Sometimes the continuing fee is slightly different to the first year fee. The variance is usually related to materials used in the course.

(The AIS subsidises TVET costs at the rate of \$650 per annum at the moment.)

Considerations When Doing A TVET Subject And The HSC

Please be advised that TAFE is an adult learning environment and is separate to school. TAFE simply advises the school of any absences and provides a progress report for the student half way through the course. The report will simply say that the student is "Competent" or "Not Yet Competent". Often "Not Yet Competent" only means that they still have to complete the course but in some cases, work that is still outstanding. TAFE sometimes doesn't have the same HSC focus that school does. Your child will need to take the initiative in his/her own learning and make sure that he/she understands what is expected from day one for doing well in the HSC exam.

Please Note: All TVET HSC results depend ENTIRELY on the HSC exam that is sat at school. Whilst course work and tasks must be completed in order to pass the TVET course, the HSC result for this course does not rely on any of these. The HSC result for the TVET course relies only on the result of the HSC exam and students need to keep this in mind over the one or two years of the course for their own revision. The student must tell the school that she/he wishes to sit the HSC exam for this TVET subject.

NB: Under the government's new Smart and Skilled initiative it is envisaged that increased prices above the usual 2% are quite likely for TVET courses in 2017.
