GIRL'S UNIFORM



Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

- Inaburra Senior skirt – to below the knee (Years 10 -12)
- Inaburra white blouse – short sleeved
- Inaburra white mid-calf socks
- Inaburra navy blazer (required on special occasions)
- Inaburra school hat (in playground and at sport)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Jogger style, ballet flats and doc martens not allowed (not available from the uniform shop). See page 8 for more details.



Winter Uniform (Terms 2 and 3)

Same as Summer uniform AND

- Inaburra white mid-calf socks or navy stockings
- Inaburra navy jumper – may only be worn as outer garment at school (optional)
- Inaburra navy blazer (every day)
- Inaburra navy scarf (optional)

BOY'S UNIFORM



Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

- Inaburra school shirt
- Inaburra long, grey pants
- Inaburra tie with top button done up
- Black socks
- Inaburra navy blazer (required for special occasions)
- Inaburra school hat (in playground and at sport)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Jogger style, ballet flats and doc martens not allowed (not available from the uniform shop). See page 8 for more details.

Winter Uniform (Terms 2 and 3)

Same as Summer uniform AND

- Inaburra navy blazer (every day)
- Inaburra navy jumper – may only be worn as outer garment at school (optional)
- Inaburra navy scarf (optional)

HOW TO WEAR THE UNIFORM

THE BLAZER & JUMPER (Monday to Thursday)



SUMMER (Terms 1 & 4)

- The blazer is only required to be worn on special occasions.
- The jumper cannot be worn as the outer garment travelling to and from school.

WINTER (Terms 2 & 3)

- The blazer must be the outer garment until after Home Group in the morning and for travelling home in the afternoon. It must also be worn to assembly.
- The jumper may be worn as the outer garment during the school day, except at assembly.

THE SPORTS UNIFORM (Friday)



SUMMER (Terms 1 & 4)

- The tracksuit is completely optional in summer. Students must wear the Inaburra branded polo shirt, shorts and sports socks.

WINTER (Terms 2 & 3)

- The full uniform, including the tracksuit pants and top, must be worn to and from school. The tracksuit may be taken off during the day.
- The navy jumper can be worn on Friday, but only under the tracksuit jacket.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

GIRL'S HAIR

- Must be completely tied up or back with a navy, white or yellow ribbon.
- The fringe should be above the eyebrows.
- Should be a natural colour.
- Should be neat and tidy at all times.

BOY'S HAIR

- Above the collar in length.
- The fringe should be above the eyebrows.
- Should be a natural colour.
- Should be neat and tidy at all times.
- Avoid extremes of hair style.

GIRL'S JEWELLERY

Only the following are allowed:

- One watch.
- One small, plain pair of stud/sleeper earrings no more than 4mm in size to be worn in the ear lobe only.

BOY'S JEWELLERY

Only the following are allowed:

- One watch.

BOY'S SHIRTS

- Must be tucked in.
- The top button must be done up and the tie straight and neat.

MAKEUP - No makeup is allowed to be worn at school. This includes nail polish.

SHOES

SCHOOL SHOES (Monday to Thursday)

- Must be shiny, plain, black, polished, lace-up, leather shoes.
- Must not be suede.
- No boots, jogger style, ballet flats or doc martens.
- Must have a low heel not all in soft sole (jogger style shoes).
- No raised ridge around the sides of the shoe.

SPORT SHOES (Friday, PE lessons and other sport activities)

- Runners or cross trainers - no excessively bright/fluorescent colours (no block colours).
