JUNIOR SCHOOL SUMMER UNIFORM - YEARS K-6



Girls' Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

- Inaburra Summer dress - knee length
- Inaburra white turn-down socks
- Inaburra navy blazer
- Inaburra school hat (in the playground and at sport)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Velcro and buckles are acceptable for K-2. Jogger style, ballet flats and Dr Martens are not allowed.

Boys' Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

- Inaburra lemon school shirt - short sleeved with top button done up
- Inaburra navy 'Bermuda' style shorts
- Inaburra striped tie
- Inaburra knee-high navy socks with yellow stripes
- Inaburra navy blazer
- Inaburra school hat (in the playground and at sport)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Velcro and buckles are acceptable for K-2. Jogger style and Dr Martens are not allowed.

JUNIOR SCHOOL WINTER UNIFORM - YEARS K-6



Girls' Winter Uniform (Terms 2 and 3)

- Inaburra navy pinstripe tunic - to below the knee
- Inaburra lemon blouse
- Inaburra navy tights, knee-high navy socks or white turn-down socks
- Inaburra navy jumper - optional layer
- Inaburra navy blazer
- Inaburra school hat (in the playground and at sport)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Velcro and buckles are acceptable for K-2. Jogger style, ballet flats and Dr Martens are not allowed.

Boys' Winter Uniform (Terms 2 and 3)

- Inaburra lemon school shirt - long or short sleeved with top button done up
- Inaburra navy pants or navy 'Bermuda' style shorts
- Inaburra striped tie
- Inaburra knee-high navy socks with yellow stripes
- Inaburra navy jumper - optional layer
- Inaburra navy blazer
- Inaburra school hat (in the playground and at sport)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Velcro and buckles are acceptable for K-2. Jogger style and Dr Martens not allowed.

SCHOOL HAT

Adequate skin protection is very important. All of the styles available offer good protection for the face and neck areas and must be worn throughout the year*. We will strongly encourage children to wear their hats/caps and ask you to support us in this endeavour.

JUNIOR SPORTS UNIFORM BOYS AND GIRLS



Summer and Winter

- Inaburra navy sport shorts - unisex design
- Inaburra sports polo shirt - unisex design
- White Inaburra sports socks
- Inaburra school cap
- Inaburra sports tracksuit - zip up track jacket and track pants (optional). Navy jumper allowed under the jacket.
- Runners or cross trainers (See following page for more details)

HOW TO WEAR THE UNIFORM

THE BLAZER & JUMPER

(Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday)



SUMMER (Terms 1 & 4)

- The blazer is only required to be worn on special occasions.
- The jumper cannot be worn as the outer garment travelling to and from school.

WINTER (Terms 2 & 3)

- The blazer must be worn to and from school. School jumpers and vests may be worn as the outer garment during school hours. In the event of unseasonably hot weather parents will be notified of any changes to these arrangements.

THE SPORTS UNIFORM (Wednesday)



SUMMER (Terms 1 & 4)

- The tracksuit is completely optional in Summer. Students must wear the Inaburra branded polo shirt, shorts and sports socks.

WINTER (Terms 2 & 3)

- The full uniform, including the tracksuit top, must be worn to and from school. Tracksuit pants are optional. The tracksuit may be taken off during the day.
- The jumper can be worn on Wednesday, but only under the tracksuit jacket.

Adequate skin protection is very important. All styles of hats offer good protection for the face and neck areas and must be worn throughout the year*.

*Compulsory in T1 and T4, optional in T3 and T4.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

GIRLS' HAIR

- Must be completely tied up or back with a navy, white or yellow ribbon if longer than above shoulder.
- The fringe should be above the eyebrows.
- Should be a natural colour.
- Should be neat and tidy at all times.

BOYS' HAIR

- Above the collar in length.
- The fringe should be above the eyebrows.
- Should be a natural colour.
- Should be neat and tidy at all times.
- Avoid extremes of hair style.

GIRLS' JEWELLERY

Only the following are allowed:

- One watch.
- One small, **plain pair** of stud/sleeper earrings no more than 4mm in size to be worn in the ear lobe only.

BOYS' JEWELLERY

Only the following is allowed:

- One watch.

BOYS' SHIRTS

- Must be tucked in.
- The top button must be done up and the tie straight and neat.

MAKEUP - No makeup is allowed to be worn at school. This includes nail polish.

SHOES

SCHOOL SHOES (Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday)

- Must be shiny, plain, black, polished, lace-up, leather shoes.
- Must not be suede.
- No boots, jogger style, ballet flats or Dr Martens style shoes.
- Must have a low heel not all in soft sole (jogger style shoes).
- No raised ridge around the sides of the shoe.

SPORT SHOES (Wednesday, PE lessons and other sport activities)

- Shoes to have adequate foot support and cushioning for physical activity (i.e. runners or cross trainers). No Canvas/Vans style shoes or skate style shoes - see image.
- No excessively bright/fluorescent colours or block colours.

SOCKS

- Must be standard Inaburra socks for boys.
- Girls should wear white turn-down socks. No ankle or crew socks to be worn.

UNABLE TO WEAR THE UNIFORM? If students are unable to wear the uniform due to an injury or other unforeseen circumstance, he/she should give a note, signed by a parent, to his/her teacher at the beginning of the day.
