

INABURRA UNIFORM GUIDELINES 10-12

SENIOR GIRLS' UNIFORM - YEARS 10-12



Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

- Inaburra Senior skirt - on or below the knee OR Inaburra Senior navy pant
- Inaburra white blouse - short sleeved
- Inaburra white turn-down socks
- Inaburra navy blazer (required on special occasions including photo day in Term 1)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Jogger style, ballet flats and Dr Martens not allowed (Shoes are not available from the Uniform Shop).

Winter Uniform (Terms 2 and 3)

- Same as Summer Uniform AND
- Inaburra white turn-down socks or navy stockings
- Inaburra navy jumper - optional layer - may only be worn as outer garment at school
- Inaburra navy blazer (every day)
- Inaburra navy scarf (optional)

SENIOR BOYS' UNIFORM - YEARS 10-12



Summer Uniform (Terms 1 and 4)

- Inaburra striped school shirt (Years 10-12) with top button done up
- Inaburra long, grey pants
- Inaburra Senior tie (Years 10-12)
- Black socks
- Inaburra navy blazer (required on special occasions including photo day in Term 1)
- Black, plain leather, shiny lace-up school shoes with a low heel and no raised ridge. Jogger style and Dr Martens not allowed. (Shoes are not available from the Uniform Shop).

Winter Uniform (Terms 2 and 3)

- Same as Summer Uniform AND
- Inaburra navy blazer (every day)
Inaburra navy jumper (optional) – may only be worn as outer garment at school
- Inaburra navy scarf (optional)

Summer and Winter

- Inaburra navy sport shorts
- Inaburra sports shirt
- White Inaburra sports socks
- Inaburra school cap
- Inaburra sports tracksuit (Navy jumper allowed under the jacket)
- Runners or cross trainers (See following page for more details)

SENIOR SCHOOL BAG

INABURRA UNIFORM GUIDELINES

HOW TO WEAR THE SENIOR UNIFORM

THE BLAZER & JUMPER

(Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday)



SUMMER (Terms 1 & 4)

- The blazer is only required to be worn on special occasions.
- The jumper cannot be worn as the outer garment travelling to and from school.

WINTER (Terms 2 & 3)

- The blazer must be the outer garment until after Home Group in the morning and for travelling home in the afternoon. It must also be worn to assembly.
- The jumper may be worn as the outer garment during the school day, except at assembly.

THE SPORTS UNIFORM (Tuesday)



SUMMER (Terms 1 & 4)

- The tracksuit is completely optional in Summer. Students must wear the Inaburra branded polo shirt, shorts and sports socks.

WINTER (Terms 2 & 3)

- The full uniform, including the tracksuit pants and top, must be worn to school. The tracksuit may be taken off during the day.
- The navy jumper can be worn on Tuesday, but only under the tracksuit jacket.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE

GIRLS' HAIR

- Must be completely tied up or back with navy, white or yellow hair accessories
- The fringe should be above the eyebrows
- Should be a natural colour
- Should be neat and tidy at all times

BOYS' HAIR

- Above the collar in length or tied back neatly off the face
- The fringe should be above the eyebrows
- Should be a natural colour
- Should be neat and tidy at all times
- Avoid extremes of hair style

GIRLS' JEWELLERY

Only the following are allowed:

- One watch
- One small, plain pair of stud/sleeper earrings no more than 4mm in size to be worn in the ear lobe only

BOYS' JEWELLERY

Only the following is allowed:

- One watch

BOYS' SHIRTS

- Must be tucked in
- The top button must be done up and the tie straight and neat

MAKEUP - No makeup is allowed to be worn at school. This includes nail polish.

SHOES

SCHOOL SHOES (Monday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday)

- Must be shiny, plain, black, polished, lace-up, leather shoes
- Must not be suede
- No boots, jogger style, ballet flats or Dr Martens style shoes
- Must have a low heel not all in soft sole (jogger style shoes)
- No raised ridge around the sides of the shoe

SPORT SHOES (Tuesday, PE lessons and other sport activities)

- Shoes to have adequate foot support and cushioning for physical activity (i.e. runners or cross trainers). No Canvas/Vans style shoes or skate style shoes - see image
- No excessively bright/fluorescent colours or block colours

UNABLE TO WEAR THE UNIFORM?

If students are unable to wear the uniform due to an injury or other unforeseen circumstance, he/she should give a note, signed by a parent, to his/her Home Group Teacher at the beginning of the day.
