

Inaburra Swimming Carnival Guidelines

The Inaburra School Carnival will closely follow the CSSA Sports Recommendations and guidelines for swimming event. For more information see the CSSA Website www.cssa.net.au.

Rolls: For those catching the bus students meet teachers at school under COLA by 8am. Those making own way to carnival need to arrive by 8:30am and have name marked off by class teacher.

Parents: are welcome to attend, \$2 spectator fee to be paid upon entry (EFT only, no cash).

Swimwear: fast skins costumes (knee length) may be worn, no 2-piece swimwear or inappropriate costumes to be worn (as in line with CSSA rulings).

Nut Aware Event: As Inaburra is a Nut Aware School we will continue to ask for your assistance in not eating nut products through the day.

Sun Safe: We would encourage all students to be sun safe. Wear a hat, cover up and be sure to reapply sunscreen throughout the day. Stay in the shade where possible and keep hydrated.

No Running: around the pool deck and surrounding areas. Children should remain in their house areas, unless competing in an event.

Announcements: will be made for competitors to go to the marshalling area for their races. Times indicated in the program are a guideline only and are in no way binding. Swimmers should report immediately marshalling calls are made.

False Starts: Any Competitor who breaks twice in the same race will be disqualified.

Appeals: to be considered must be made to Mrs Carroll no later than 15 minutes after the event concerned.

Age Groups: events will be conducted in the following age groups: under 8, 9, 10, 11, 12+ years; based on the age students turn in 2023. All races will be completed in heats as timed finals. 50m: ages under 8, 9, 10, 11, 12+ years, 100m Freestyle and 200m Individual Medley: JNR (8-10), SNR (11-12+), 50m Butterfly: JNR (8-10), 11, 12+. Strong swimmers only to enter 100 Freestyle, 200IM and Butterfly.

Medley Order: Butterfly, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Freestyle

Breaststroke kick must be symmetrical.

Breaststroke & Butterfly competitors must touch the wall with both hands.

House Competition: participation in an event will earn your House 1 point, additional points will be awarded for places in each event.

Age Champions: the winner of each age group will be determined by the student who accumulates the most points during the carnival. Age Champions are determined based on performance in each of the following events – All 50m Strokes, 100m freestyle and Individual medley. Points for places are: 1st = 10 pts, 2nd = 8 pts, 3rd = 6 pts, 4th = 4 pts, 5th = 2 pts. Note: House points for participation in 25m events will be given, however, these do not count towards Age Champion point scores.

Awards – Competitors who placed overall in the top 3 in each age group for each event will receive a 1st, 2nd or 3rd ribbon; however, this does not mean all students who get a ribbon are chosen to represent Inaburra at the CSSA South Met Zone Carnival. Age Champions will be announced and Inaburra Team will be selected once results have been finalised.

Inaburra Representative Team

This carnival acts as the basis for selection of the Inaburra team to compete at the CSSA South Met Swimming Carnival on Monday 27 February 2023 at Prairiewood Leisure Centre.
