CAMBODIA RURAL SCHOOL VILLAGE PROJECT

The Cambodia Rural School Village Project (RSVP) is a service based program in which students will partner with the Global Learning Foundation (GLF) and local leaders to help support remote villages.

Students will be involved in guided construction work and education programs with local children and their families. There will also be opportunities to visit some of the significant historical cultural sites in Cambodia.

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AMPLE PROGRAM

Activity	Description
Community Service Project	Students participate in a significant project for a local village, for example renovating an existing school building or assisting with building a new school, based on village needs at the time. At the end of the program, students will enjoy the Project Completion Ceremony, with an official presentation to the local village.
Village Interaction	Over the course of the service project, students will get the opportunity to play games with and get to know children from the village and their families.
Historical and Cultural Exploration	 Students will have the opportunity to visit a range of sites of historical and cultural significance including: Angkor Wat Landmine museum Kulen Mountain Ton Le Sap Lake

TRAVEL

Students will fly economy class on Singapore or Vietnam Airlines. Transit around Cambodia is by chartered coach or minibus. Travel arrangements for the Cambodia RSVP program are made by Global Learning Expeditions (GLE), the logistics arm of GLF.

SAFETY AND SECURITY Students will be supervised by Inaburra staff as well as fully qualified and experienced GLF leaders and local project guides. Students will be expected to adhere to the school code of conduct at all times. GLF and GLE have 25 years of experience in providing safe and sustainable environments for youth work and have developed and maintained significant risk assessments over time. Students will be briefed on particular aspects of safety in preparation for the program and will also have an orientation session upon arrival in Cambodia.

MAXIMUM NUMBERS AND TEACHER/STUDENT RATIOS

This program has a target maximum of 25 students. There will be an approximate teacher/student ratio of 1:7.

ACCOMMODATION

Accommodation is based on 3-star hotel in Siem Reap.

COST AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

The cost of the Rural Cambodia Global Education program is estimated to be \$5800. The final cost of the program is dependent on several variables including (but not limited to) student numbers and currency fluctuations. This amount will be communicated at a later date and will cover:

- Return International Economy Class Airfares (Vietnam Airlines)
- Airport transfers & chartered vehicles
- Local Project Manager in Cambodia
- Materials and resources for RSVP
- Travel insurance
- All meals
- Minimum tips for driver and guides
- Project Pack including backpack and 2 x T-shirts

The final amount does not cover:

- Passport application fees
- Spending money
- Additional money for tipping
- Vaccinations if applicable

Inaburra and GLE require this program to be paid in instalments. Instalment amounts and due dates will be outlined in detail, along with other key information about the program, once itineraries and total costs are determined. This program also requires certain documentation (eg. passport information) to be provided at particular times in order to book transport and accommodation. Details of dates for this will also be conveyed in due course. Please be aware that due to the nature of travel and accommodation, payment deadlines for this program will be very tight and must be strictly adhered.
