GREATER SYDNEY

The Greater Sydney Global Education program provides Inaburra students with an insight into the lives of other Sydney locals and opportunities to serve them.

This program offers a range of activities that highlight the need and relative disadvantage of others as well as the diversity of others' experiences in the Sydney area. Students also have opportunities to develop their own life skills.

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SAMPLE PROGRAM

Activity	Description
Rough Edges	Students visit Rough Edges and explore the inner city communities around St John's Anglican Church, Darlinghurst.
Samaritan's Purse	Samaritan's Purse International Relief is a Christian organisation with a range of welfare initiatives in the developing world. Students have the opportunity to visit the Operation Christmas Child processing centre and assisting with the packing of shoe-boxes to be distributed to underprivileged children around the world.
Urban Exploration*	Students participate in a series of activities in and around Sydney city. Previous urban explorations have involved self-management, navigation and budgeting exercises, as well as visits to Wayside Chapel, King's Cross recovery centres. Students will have opportunities to serve homeless and other disadvantaged people through affiliated charities (*subject to viability).
Cultural	Visits to explore other cultures such as the Sydney Jewish Museum, Mosque and lunch at a Lebanese restaurant.
Local Service	Students join local council bushcare groups to undertake conservation work and visit Warena Aged Care Village.

TRAVEL

The mode of travel to and from activities varies. On most days students will be required to meet at school before travelling by chartered transport, public transport or foot to their venues. It is possible that students may be required to make their own way to alternative muster points (eg. Sutherland Station) for some activities. Further details about travel will be provided when itineraries are finalised.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Students will be supervised by teachers, as well as staff from organisations involved in the program. Students will be expected to adhere to the School's **Code of Conduct** at all times. Specific details about safety and security of the various programs will be published in the program booklet.

MAXIMUM NUMBERS AND TEACHER/STUDENT RATIOS

There are no maximum numbers for this program, though students may be broken into smaller groups during some activities. There will be an approximate teacher/student ratio of 1:20, although this will vary depending on the activity.

ACCOMMODATION

The Greater Sydney program allows students to return home each night. Accommodation for the Urban Exploration component of the program, if available, is hostel/dormitory style. Further details about accommodation will be provided when itineraries are finalised.

COST AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

All costs for the Greater Sydney Global Education program are included in school fees, however, students will be required to provide their own lunches on most days.
