Terms and Conditions:

- When a student is to be withdrawn from Inaburra School a minimum of one full term's notice must be provided to the Principal in writing. One term's fees may be charged in lieu of withdrawal.
- Fees are charged in two billings – in January and June each year. Payment is due in full on the due date provided on each account. Late Payment Fees apply. [Details below](#).
- Year 12 will be billed two semesters regardless of when they finish attending the School.
- The schedule of fees is inclusive of all tuition costs, including camps, excursions etc. Variation occurs because of the different curriculum activities, as applied to the respective year.
- Other items charged separately to the schedule of fees may include Global Education, Elective Tours, TVET costs, Year 6 farewell, Year 10 and Year 12 formals, equipment which attracts GST, some elective choices for major works, additional excursions, etc. or any other fee which the School may determine.
- Tax Deductibility: Only Building Fund [donations](#) are tax deductible. The compulsory levies are not tax deductible.
- The Sibling Discount may not necessarily apply at the same level of discount in subsequent years.
- A student's enrolment will be discontinued if fees remain unpaid. In addition, a student may not be eligible to participate in non-compulsory school events (e.g. Band Tours, Global Ed trips etc.) unless tuition fees are fully paid.

This request includes a link which will provide direct debit and Visa, Mastercard or Amex payment options. Surcharges apply. Direct debit payments can take 3-5 working days to clear and reflect in the portal. Credit Card payments will reflect in real time.
