GREATER SYDNEY

The Greater Sydney Global Education program provides Inaburra students with an insight into the lives of other Sydney locals and opportunities to serve them.

This program offers a range of activities that highlight the need and relative disadvantage of others as well as the diversity of others' experiences in the Sydney area. Students also have opportunities to develop their own life skills.

SAMPLE PROGRAM

ACTIVITY	DESCRIPTION
Urban Exploration (with optional overnight stay*)	Students participate in a series of activities in and around Sydney city. Previous urban explorations have involved self-management, navigation and budgeting exercises, as well as visits to Salvos City Homeless Project and Rough Edges service for the homeless. Students will have opportunities to serve other disadvantaged people through affiliated charities. Overnight accommodation at Inner City Youth Hostel (*subject to viability).
Cultural	Visits to explore other cultures such as the Auburn Gallipoli Mosque, lunch at a Lebanese restaurant, visit to Harris Park Indian precinct and temple.
Local Service	Students join with and learn about local community and church groups that contribute to the community with welfare needs and environmental conservation and protection. Students visit Warena Aged Care Village in Bangor and engage with residents in activities.

TRAVEL

The mode of travel to and from activities varies. On most days students will be required to meet at school before travelling by chartered transport, public transport or foot to their venues. It is possible that students may be required to make their own way to alternative muster points (eg. Sutherland Station) for some activities. Further details about travel will be provided when itineraries are finalised.

SAFETY AND SECURITY

Students will be supervised by teachers, as well as staff from organisations involved in the program. Students will be expected to adhere to the School's Code of Conduct at all times. Specific details about safety and security of the various programs will be published in the program booklet.

MAXIMUM NUMBERS AND TEACHER/STUDENT RATIOS

There are no maximum numbers for this program, though students may be broken into smaller groups during some activities. There will be an approximate teacher/student ratio of 1:20, although this will vary depending on the activity.

ACCOMMODATION

The Greater Sydney program allows students to return home each night. Accommodation for the Urban Exploration component of the program, if available, is hostel/dormitory style. Further details about accommodation will be provided when itineraries are finalised.

COST AND PAYMENT SCHEDULE

Costs for the Greater Sydney Global Education program are included in school fees. If the overnight stay option is selected, approximate cost is \$400. Students will be required to provide their own lunches on some days.
